A caravan will leave the San Miguel Mission parking lot promptly at 1:45 p.m. The mission is located 10 miles north of Paso Robles on Hwy. 101. Directions: Take Hwy. 101 north from Paso Robles to the San Miguel exit. About 3 blocks north of the Mission, follow the sign for Parkfield pointing east. Crossing the river on the new bridge, turn left onto Indian Valley Road and follow the signs to Parkfield. Watch for the "Wayside Cross" signs on the left approximately 14 miles from San Miguel.
