


Benediction Weekly

For those living below the poverty line, washing clothes presents both a logistical problem and a financial hardship. Laundry Love partners with local laundromats in cleaning the clothes of those living in shelters, motels, cars, garages and on the streets. The idea was born at St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Ventura, California. The story of Laundry Love began with T-Bone (Eric), a homeless gentleman who said, "If I had clean clothes I think people would treat me like a human being."

- We will give priority in the back pew on the south end for families with children. You can sit there, but please be prepared to move if a family shows up. We don't want them to leave because there's no space for them.
