Did you know? One of the advantages of grey hair is that you can donate to St Benedict's and save taxes at the same time! The IRS requires those of us who are over 701/2 and have an IRA account to make a minimum annual withdrawing. You can now give up to \$100,000 per year from your IRA directly to St. Benedict's without paying any income tax on it. The donation must be made directly from your IRA account to St. Benedict's.
