Our bishop connects us to the wider Episcopal Church and to the Anglican Communion through the House of Bishops - which is why she is the one to welcome new adult members into the church through confirmation or reception.

The process of selecting a new Bishop and transferring the diocese to her or his care is already underway. The diocesan Standing Committee has the responsibility for this process. Both Caro+ and Lisa Gonzalez currently serve on the Standing Committee, which has selected a Search Committee to create a profile of the person we're looking for, accept and screen applicants and create a slate of potential bishops. Senior Warden Pamela Bleisch is serving on this committee. We will elect the next Bishop at a special Electing Convention in June 2019.

Update on Fire Sprinkler System: It's a Go!

The story so far: after many years of agreeing that we do not need a fire sprinkler system, the County changed their mind. Two generous donations made the installation possible but we had to wait for PG&E to tell us their price for supplying additional power for the pump.

This month's update: We have received the quote from PG&E (\$23k) and have signed the contract.

The main contractor (Sims) had to increase his estimate by \$7k because of the rise in steel cost. That contract has now been signed, as has that with the electrician. So we are looking at \$119,720 without the cost of repairing ceilings etc after the sprinkler heads have been re-installed. This is in line with the \$120,000 we have been anticipating. Right now there is \$111k in the Sprinkler Fund plus \$9k in the Building Fund.

We have the money, we have the contracts signed. Now we wait for the contractors to start. They will be replacing the big green water tanks with steel ones, installing an external pump and pumphouse, refitting the interior pipes with sprinkler heads and adding new ones where necessary.
