The Second Sunday after the Epiphany—Year C

Welcome to our parish. The feast of the Epiphany directed our attention to the ways in which Christ is manifest in the Gospels, and by extension, how he is manifest in our lives. The theme of showing forth is continued in the Sundays after the Epiphany. Today's Gospel carries the third of the three classical themes of Epiphany: Jesus' first miracle, changing water into wine at the marriage feast in Cana of Galilee.

The Old Testament used the marriage relationship and the marriage feast as symbols or archetypes of God's relationship to the chosen people and of the ultimate consummation of that relationship in the establishment of the Kingdom. Today's passage from Isaiah is based on that image.

At the marriage feast, Jesus produced around 150 gallons of wine (God is lavish, even profligate, in giving grace) and it is much better wine than the host at the dinner had been serving (God's grace far surpasses what we can do for ourselves).

We are a people transformed by our relationship to God and given the grace and illumination of the Holy Spirit. The marriage images in the first and third readings describe the intimate and total nature of God's relationship to us which results of the gift of the Holy Spirit given us in baptism.

# Diversity Sensitivity Training for Congregation Leaders Saturday, February 23<sup>rd</sup> or March 9<sup>th</sup>

The diocese will host two separate Diversity Sensitivity Training events in February and March – the first at St. Timothy's Episcopal Church in Mountain View on February 23, and the second at St. Barnabas in Arroyo Grande on March 9. These are one-day trainings (10am-4pm) that will meet the requirements for "anti-racism" training required for all lay licenses and for local parish leaders (vestry, etc.). Attending the full day is required to receive the certificate of completion. Anyone from any part of the diocese may attend either of these trainings. Pre-registration is required by February 15 for the Santa Clara Valley Deanery training and March 1 for the San Luis Obispo training.
