Learn about elder abuse & how to avoid SCAMS at this informational workshop to be presented by Angela Viles and Lauri Gomez, of the SLO County District Attorneys office on *Wed.*, *March 6<sup>th</sup> from 2pm-3:30pm* at the Morro Shores Mobile Home Park club house, 633 Ramona, Los Osos.

Do you want to know more about the scams in our County and what steps you can take to keep from being trapped and lose your money? Do you know someone who has suffered elder abuse? Come and learn what to do if you or a friend is a possible victim. The San Luis Obispo County District Attorney's Office would like the public to be aware of a variety of money transfer scams within our county.

The San Luis Obispo County Victim Witness Assistance Center works to reduce the trauma, frustration and inconvenience experienced by victims, witnesses, and family members affected by crime. They do this by providing a wide variety of services to victims of crime and their families, in addition to supporting victims and witnesses throughout the criminal justice process. As part of their mission, they inform victims of their constitutional and statutory rights under California law, and how to exercise those rights.
