Body Prayer, part 2: Bowing

We bow to each other or to God in order to show our reverence. Common times to bow are:

- Whenever Jesus Christ is mentioned (because "at the Name of Jesus every knee shall bow")
- When we pass in front of the altar or tabernacle
- During the Nicene Creed when we remember the astonishing love shown in the incarnation: "he came down from heaven, he became incarnate..."
- When the Gloria Patri is said, "Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit"
- During the Sanctus "Holy, holy, holy..."
- When the Processional Cross or the Gospel Book passes us
- At the end of the Communion circle
