Two Presentations by Michael Lucas, Cal Poly Professor Emeritus in Architecture

Sacred Light – Gothic Light (March 7th at 3pm) *Origins of the Gothic and English Cathedrals*

Sacred Light Gothic Light will examine the origins of the Gothic by Abbot Suger in Paris, inspired by writing attributed to St. Denis, and its lightning-like expansion across northern Europe and especially the English Gothic. Michael's own images will include Durham, Salisbury, Ely, Winchester, and York Cathedrals, Cambridge and Oxford.

Sacred Light – Nordic Light (March 14th at 3pm) *Contemporary Faith & Form in Denmark and Finland*

Sacred Light Nordic Light will examine examples of contemporary/post-WW II spiritual architecture from urban and rural Denmark and Finland, rethinking wood, stone, space and light, including works of the great Finnish architect, Alar Aalto.

Study for Confirmation and Reception in the Episcopal Church And Reaffirmation of Baptismal Vows for those already confirmed

A five week study, based on the Baptismal Covenant, is being offered at St. Benedict's in preparation for confirmation or reception in the Episcopal Church by Bishop Lucinda Ashby during her visit on Sunday, July 12. Those already confirmed can reaffirm their vows at the same time. The classes will be held following our 10:30 service, starting March 1. Activities will include journaling, reviewing the Bible, the Book of Common Prayer, Christian beliefs and practices and history of the Episcopal Church. Each session will last no more than 90 minutes, with some preparation by each participant between sessions. The class will be mentored by Lisa Gonzalez, "a cradle Episcopalian", who was confirmed at 11, but didn't really know what it meant at the time, except that now she could take communion.
